

Certificate III in TESOL



The Certificate III in TESOL is an entry-level qualification for people who want to become English teachers. During the course you will develop basic skills in classroom presentation techniques, lesson and resource preparation, and classroom management. You will gain the knowledge and skills to assist learners to improve their grammar, pronunciation and speech, and you will also develop an awareness of cultural issues likely to be encountered with English language learners in different countries.

To attain the Certificate III in TESOL you need to complete five (5) compulsory Units of competency as follows:

TAEDEL401A Plan, organise and deliver group-based learning

This unit provides the skills and knowledge to plan and organise lesson content and activities, and resources specifically for the group of learners you will be teaching. It also provides the skills and knowledge to deliver lessons using effective presentation, communication, observation and interpersonal skills. It also shows you how to support and monitor learning and evaluate the effectiveness of your lessons

TESCUL301A Develop and apply knowledge of cultural factors affecting teachers of EFL/ESL

This unit discusses a range of cultural factors that affect EFL/ESL learners and how to deal with them. It shows you how to communicate effectively and cope with different cultures.

TESPRN302A Assist EFL/ESL learners with pronunciation and speech

This unit provides the skills and knowledge required to assist EFL/ESL learners to improve their pronunciation and speech. The topics covered include phonemic symbols, intonation, rhythm and stress, and sound production.

TESGRM303A Assist EFL/ESL learners with grammar

This unit provides the skills and knowledge required to assist EFL/ESL learners to increase their knowledge of grammar and to use grammar correctly. It also shows you how to identify and correct errors, and find suitable grammar resources.

TESRES304A Source and develop resources to support EFL/ESL learning

This unit provides the skills and knowledge required to find and/or design, develop, use and review resources to support EFL/ESL learning for learners with different language levels.
